



## 9-Patch Premie Quilt

This kit includes nine  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares and 4 border strips. Flannel backing fabric may also be included. Batting is not used.

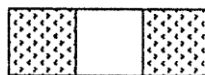
\*Fabric requirements: Fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of color A      Color A       Color B   
 Fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of color B  
 Fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd. of border fabric  
 Fat  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. of cotton flannel for backing (20" x 20")

\*Cutting instructions: Cut color A into five  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares  
 Cut color B into four  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares  
 Cut border fabric into four 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips (at least 20" long)

Sew the squares together into 3 rows of 3 squares each using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam.



First row

Third row

Press the seams toward the darker squares.

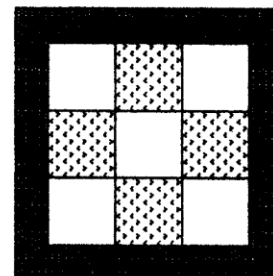
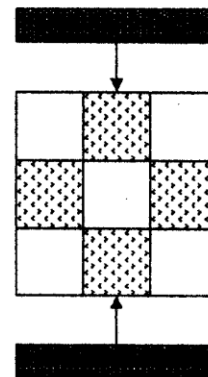
Sew the three rows together to form the 9-patch quilt center.

Sew a border strip to two opposite sides of the quilt. Trim borders even with the quilt. Sew on the other two border strips and trim.

Lay quilt on top of backing fabric, right sides together. Sew around quilt using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam and leaving a 4" opening for turning. Turn quilt right side out and press.

Slip stitch the opening closed. Machine quilt in-the-ditch around border and *between* the squares. *Top stitch edges.*

Finished quilt is approximately 20" square.
