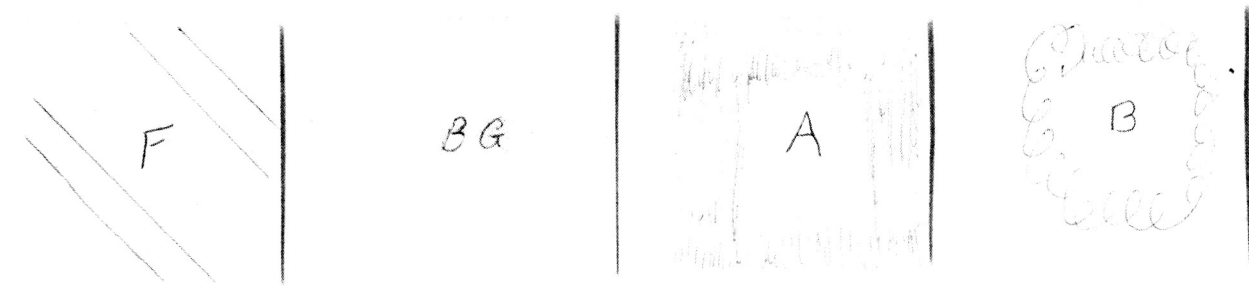
I hope you will enjoy this mystery quilt over the next months. I have asked Yolanda to post on the web site suggestions for doing a mystery quilt. The finished size of the quilt is 64" x 72", just right to wrap yourself in on those cold nights

Directional fabrics are not recommended for the background and coordinates. The Background fabric is quite a bit of the quilt and should be an interesting print.

You will have from August to April to complete the quilt. We will show the quilts at our April meeting. I hope some of the members who leave in the Winter will take part. Your quilts can be shown when you return next spring.

All the fabric cuts should be done with the fabric folded, selvage-to-selvage, as it comes off the bolt. Be sure to remove all selvage edges before cutting blocks.

Keep your suspects in groups as you cut them, Label the groups according to their fabric ID and piece sizes, as given in the List of Suspects. Be sure to sew with a consistent 1/4-inch seam.
