

Kits and Supply Lists for all Sewing Workshops

All workshops have a materials kit fee. The fees for these kits are collected by George at the end of the workshop. This is a must as it eliminates unnecessary confusion

Kit #1 (required) - \$20.00 per student - This kit includes the following items:

A specially designed (patent pending) 8" seam allowance guide ,retail \$12.00

The original pattern for the workshop, which includes:

All foundations printed on "Foundation Stuff"

Block schematic, cutting chart, fabric gradation chart and a worksheet.

All patterns retail for \$20.

The total kit is a \$32.00 value.

Workshop students only pay \$20.00 for kit#1!

Kit #2 - \$50.00 per student - includes all items in kit#1 plus:

2- six step gradations (1/4 yard each color, 12 colors in all) retail \$24.00

1 yard of a background fabric retail \$8.00*

*For the "Ascending Logs" pattern only you will receive, 1/2 yard of

background fabric, 1/8 yard of each an accent color, a light, medium and dark color for the diamonds.

Total kit #2 is a \$64.00 value.

Workshop students only pay \$50.00 for kit#2!

Student Supply List

1. sewing machine (in good working order, Please check it out before you come to the workshop) with an open toe foot (quilters foot is a good one)
2. rotary cutter (nice and sharp, a new blade would be nice) with a cutting mat and 6" or 12" ruler. Rulers not necessary for workshop students as I will give you my "Triple Duty Seam Allowance Guides" with your workshop kit.
3. light gray or white thread in bobbin and spool
4. plus all of the other items you need to sew pieces together.

Fabric (for those who do not purchase kit#2, you will need)

Two complimentary colors in a 6 step gradation (total of 12 colors) from very light to very dark.(minimum,1/4 yd each shade). Also 1 yard* of a dark background fabric. (I like black). They must be solids or a very small prints that "read" as solids. Please, no calicoes. I will also have a good supply of fabric in the event you change your mind, with over 135 colors to choose from.
