

SPLIT 9 PATCH QUILT

This quilt can be made with almost any size squares with probably a 3" minimum. It can be totally scrap with 5 darks and 4 lights or planned with 3 or 4 different fabrics. It helps to have good contrast between the corners and the other blocks. The middle square can be the same as the corners or different.

All squares need to be the same size and sewn into like 9 patches.

Cut the completed 9 patches in $\frac{1}{2}$ horizontally and vertically (not diagonally but that might be interesting too!) Then switch one set of opposites to make a new pattern.

Sew the blocks together. (I made 12 9 patches from 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and got a fairly large lap quilt or small twin). You could also make 2 quilts from that.
